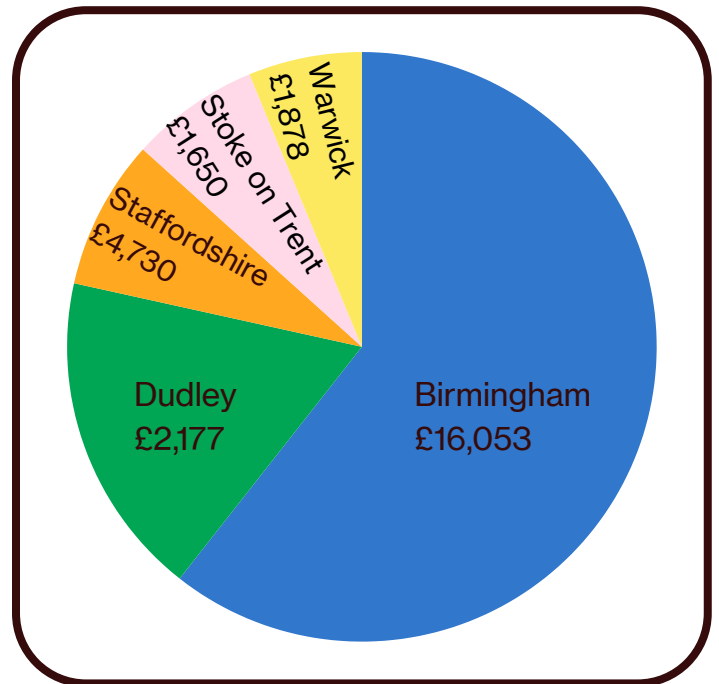
Chances for Children Grants

As requested, your donation has been used to fund both Chances for Children Grants and Boarding Grants.

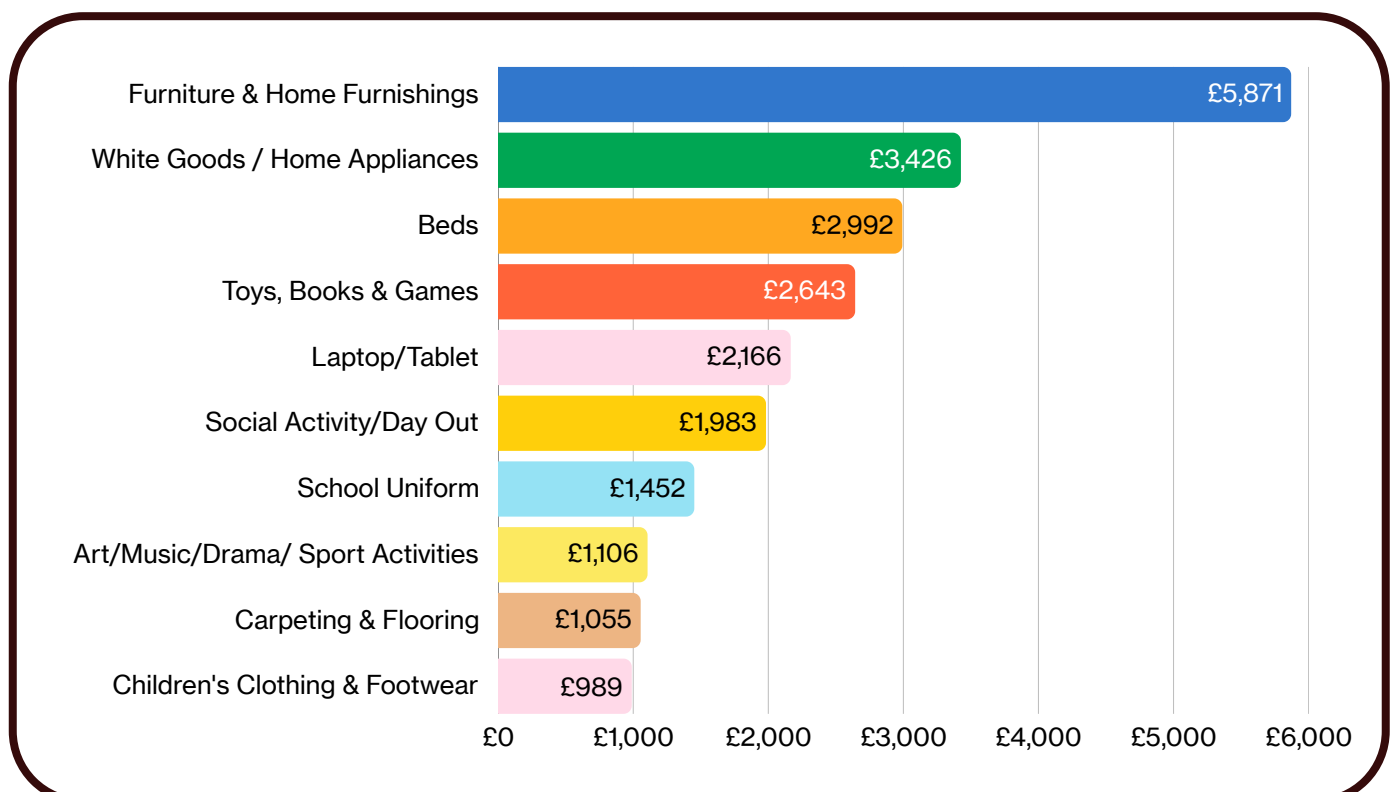
Your donation of £26,420 helped to provide 14 Chances for Children grants, supporting 31 children and young people.

All grants were awarded in the West Midlands, which has the 2nd highest percentage of children living in poverty in the UK at 36.7%.

Matt & Amy's Story

Matt (13) and Amy (9) left their home after their mother had experienced severe domestic abuse. They left in such a hurry they were forced to stay on friends' sofas before moving endlessly from one temporary bed and breakfast hotel to another for over a year.

Matt and Amy found it hard to settle in at school as they kept moving and had no time to build friendships. Matt became verbally abusive to his mum and sister and Amy became emotionally withdrawn.

Finally, they were given a permanent home and they were able to improve their attendance at school and start to make friends.

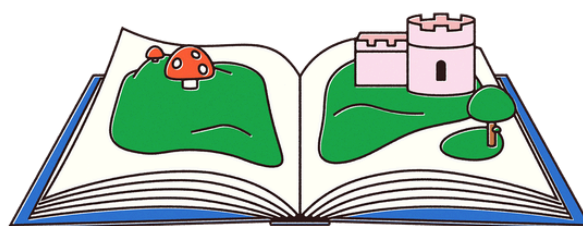

Thanks to you we were able to make sure the family had all the things they needed to turn the page and start a new chapter together.

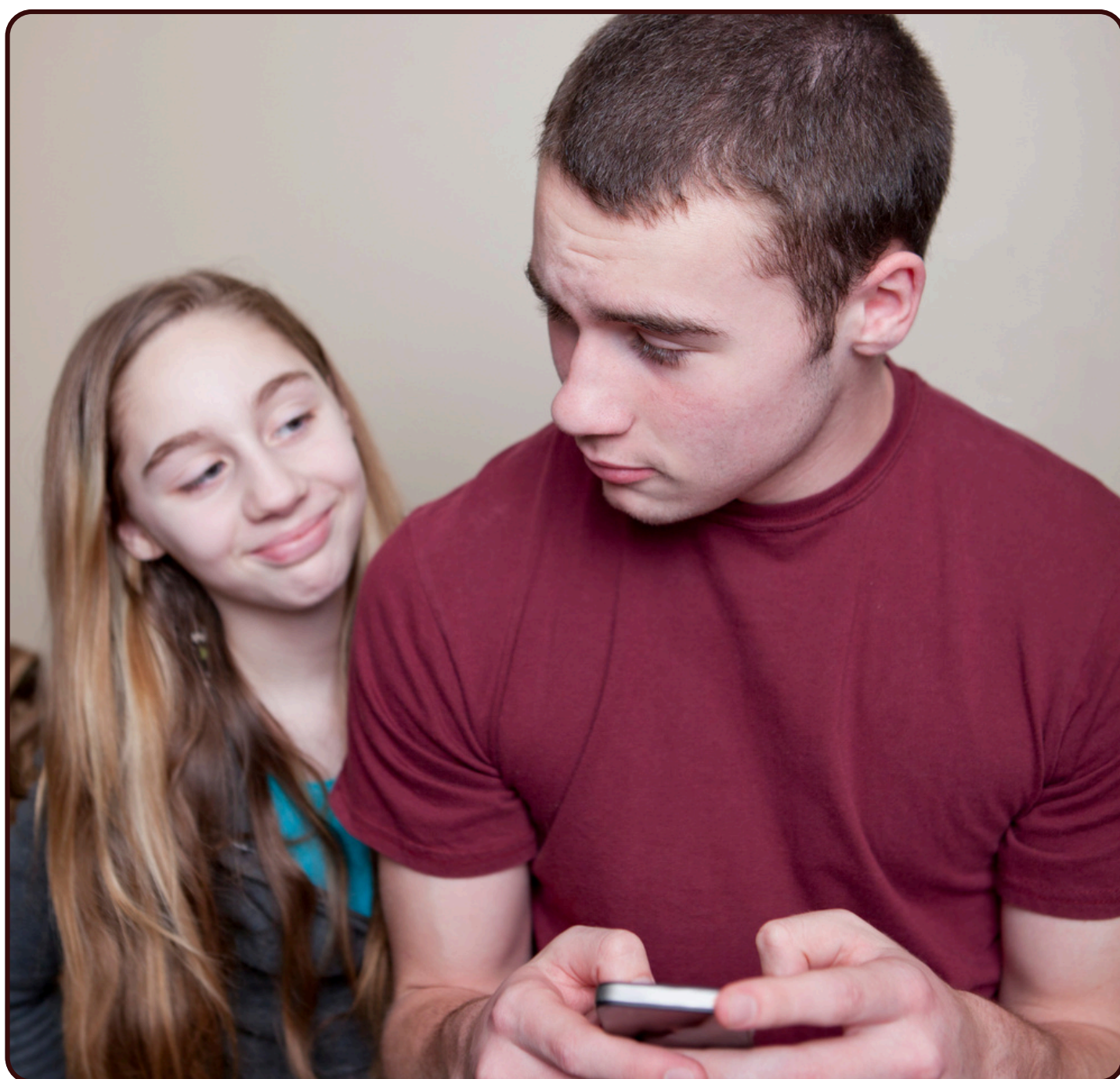

Support to boarding

Olivia

The remaining £30,000 of your donation has supported six young people to attend boarding school. Buttle UK has been working to fund vulnerable children to attend boarding schools for most of its 70-year history. Here is an update on Olivia, one of the young people supported by Buttle.

Olivia's life with her mother is very turbulent. Her mother, Amy struggles with multiple physical and mental conditions. Olivia is often called on to support her mother, who will sometimes wake her up in the night or early hours of the morning to help her deal with a health crisis. At times Olivia has lived with other carers, in order to provide relief but this has been sporadic. Her father does provide some support but does not take on regular care. Olivia has been a strong academic student and we were able to find a place for Olivia starting in 2022.

Olivia continues to do well at boarding school and excel, in particular, in performing arts. She was recently awarded a scholarship at the school, which includes becoming an Ambassador for the performing arts and accessing opportunities tailored to pursuing a career in this area. Olivia's mother continues to struggle with multiple physical and mental health challenges and is exceptionally positive about the impact of boarding on Olivia.
